## CDSCO nixes cancer drug trial, gets notice

The Bombay High Court has issued notice to the Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation (CDSCO) and the Union government in a petition filed by Nashik-based Datar Cancer Genetics, challenging the rejection of its application to begin Phase I human trials of its cancer immunotherapy drug, Per-C-Vax, for patients recently diagnosed with solid organ cancers.

A bench of Chief Justice Alok Aradhe and Justice MS Karnik was hearing the plea filed through S Mahomedbhai & Co, Advocates & Solicitors, Datar, which is involved in

cancer research, has termed the CDSCO's April 22 rejection of its trial application as "arbitrary", "unscientific", and a "fraud on the statute". Calling the rejection mala fide and a misuse of power, the company has urged the Court to set aside the order and direct CDSCO to grant trial approval.

The vaccine, Per-C-Vax, has been reported as an indigenous immunotherapy developed from patient-derived tumour cells or cell lines. CDSCO rejected Datar's application for lack of pre-clinical animal data, which according to the firm is scientifically unviable for such a therapy. Datar contends that this demand ignores the nature of the therapy and international

As per the firm, the vaccine is being used in the USA and Germany and the company wants to produce it in India and sell it for less than Rs1000

even though they have spent Rs2,000 on every unit. Senior counsel Rafiq Dada, representing Datar, has submitted that the vaccine would be given to critical patients first at the trial stage.

Datar had applied for trial approval on August 2, 2023, under the New Drugs and Clinical Trials (NDCT) Rules, 2019. As per Rule 23, CDSCO is required to respond within 30 working days, after which the application is "deemed approved". Datar claims the deadline lapsed on September 15, 2023, without any deficiency letter being issued. Yet, CDSCO raised further queries on September 21 and, despite Datar's detailed reply submitted on November 28,

rejected the application seven months later.

The Drugs Controller General of India, in its April 22 order, termed the application "incomplete" and said Form CT-4A, used to invoke deemed approval, was not applicable.

Datar cited the US FDA's 2011 guidance allowing exemption from animal studies for therapeutic cancer vaccines of a previously tested class. It also submitted in vitro data and referred to earlier human trials of similar therapies. A toxicity study was also conducted at IISER Pune, which the CDSCO dismissed due to lack of Good Laboratory Practice (GLP) accreditation.

## MU launches 20 industry integrated degree courses

The University of Mumbai (MU) on Thursday announced it will launch 20 undergraduate Apprenticeship Embedded Degree Programmes (AEDP) from the current academic year.

The programmes, to be offered through the university's Garware Institute of Career Education and Development, will include apprenticeship training in collaboration with industry partners. The move follows the Maharashtra government's recent approval to implement AEDP across all non-agricultural public universities and eligible affiliated colleges, in line with University Grants Commission (UGC) guidelines and the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

year degree programme will complete at least one semester (20 credits) of apprenticeship, while those in four-year courses will undergo two semesters (40 credits) of on-the-job training. Participants will also receive stipends during their apprenticeships, and academic credits will be awarded under the NEP 2020's credit framework.

MU Vice-Chancellor Prof. Ravindra Kulkarni termed AEDP a transformative initiative and said students will gain real-world industry experience, which will significantly enhance their employability.

## Shivaji Maharaj's legacy in NCERT textbooks

The history of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj will soon be incorporated in National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) textbooks. The decision was taken during a high-level review meeting held in New Delhi between state school education minister Dadaji Bhuse and Union minister Dharmendra Pradhan.

The state government had formally requested the inclusion of Shivaji Maharaj's contributions in the national curriculum to ensure that students across the country gain a more comprehensive understanding of his role in Indian history. Bhuse said, "It is a matter of immense pride that students nationwide will now

learn about the valour, vision, and leadership of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj through our national curriculum."

However, the decision has sparked some concern among education experts. Prof Furqan Qamar, former advisor to the Planning Commission (now NITI Aayog), issued a cautionary note to the NCERT, stating, "As a national and autonomous body, NCERT must function independently and must not fall prey to political agendas."

The FPJ recently reported significant changes to NCERT's Class 7 social science textbooks for 2025-26, with chapters on the Mughal Empire being replaced with highlights of ancient Indian dynasties, pilgrimage centres, and the country's cultural heritage.

## Not all polluting industry data online, notes NGT

The National Green Tribunal (NGT) has directed the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB) to file a reply affidavit to an application that seeks publication of names of industries allegedly involved in environmental damage, for the sake of transparency and accountability.

The application filed by one Vishal Rajmahadik has sought compliance data for all categories for all polluting industries to be made public online. The tribunal directed him to identify these polluting industries, implead them and issue notices. For this, the applicant's counsel sought time until the last week of June.

As per the application, the tribunal's intervention has been sought over ineffective implementation of the online environmental monitoring system for highly polluting

industries. However, the NGT noted that it appeared the applicant was seeking a directive to the Central body and MPCB to ensure public access to real-time compliance data for 17 categories of polluting industries. "We checked the CPCB's website ourselves and found that the information is already available. It appears that data provided by industries has been uploaded. However, industries that have not submitted data are not listed. Thus, it is possible that several industries have failed to provide their data," the tribunal observed, adding that it cannot pass an order against those whose details are not published as the applicant has not identified them.

## Ground truthing of Ramsar sites: HC wants all details

The Bombay High Court on Thursday directed the state government and the wetlands authority to submit details of the steps taken to protect Ramsar Convention sites in Maharashtra.

A bench comprising Chief Justice Alok Aradhe and Justice MS Karnik sought affidavits explaining the action taken for "ground truthing" and "ground demarcation" of the three Ramsar-designated wetlands in Maharashtra. Ground truthing is the process of verifying and refining data from satellites and drones by comparing it to on-ground observations.

The HC took cognisance of the issue on January 10, following a Supreme Court order dated December 11, 2024, directing all high courts to initiate proceedings for the protection of Ramsar sites.

Ramsar sites are wetlands of international importance,

designated under the Ramsar Convention, signed in Ramsar, Iran, in 1971. India has 85 such sites, three of which are in Maharashtra: Lonar Lake in Buldhana district, Nandur Madhameshwar in Nashik district, and Thane Creek. The HC, while issuing the notices, appointed senior advocate Janak Dwarkadas as amicus curiae (friend of the court).

On Thursday, Dwarkadas referred to the apex court order, which noted that, according to the Indian Space Research Organisation, India had 2,01,503 wetlands larger than 2.25 hectares before 2017. By 2021, the number had risen to 2,31,195. Although the number has increased, ground truthing has not been carried out. "This process has been neglected by all States," Dwarkadas said.

As per the SC order, the process was to complete in three months of its issuance last December. Dwarkadas urged the court to direct the state to expedite the process.

# Mutual funds chase value in beaten-down mid, small-caps

The investment landscape of the March 2025 quarter (Q4FY25) saw a notable contrarian move by mutual funds. Amid broader market discussions about stretched valuations, these institutional investors strategically allocated significant capital to a select group of mid- and small-cap stocks.

A Mint analysis of mutual fund shareholding data across 1,168 BSE's large-, mid-, and small-cap shows a clear pivot towards underperforming names with perceived turnaround prospects. Five stocks—TeamLease Services, Happiest Minds Technologies, South Indian Bank, Max Financial Services, and AWL Agri Business—stood out for seeing the steepest surge in institutional interest, despite lagging stock prices.

Small-cap staffing company TeamLease Services emerged as the top pick for mutual funds in Q4FY25, with institutional ownership surging by 10.9 percentage points to 45.44%—even as the stock plunged 38% during the same period. The company's valuation has become attractive, with its P/E ratio dropping to 32x—far below its five-year average of 100x.

Despite short-term pressures, 92% of analysts polled by Bloomberg suggest a 'buy' or 'hold' ratings for the stock. The pressure on their staffing business is expected to ease further. "Going into 4Q, management anticipates a marginal decline in headcount due to headwind in BFSI and slow-down in certain pockets of the general staffing business, that should normalize by IQFY26," said an Antique Stock Broking research report. The company is expected to announce its

Mid-cap player AWL Agri Business witnessed a dramatic rise in MF stakes—from a marginal stake in December to 8.47% in March quarter even as its shares dropped 16%. The company delivered 9% year-on-year volume growth in Q4 and notched record annual revenue of ₹63,672 crore.

"We are well-positioned to capitalize on the shift towards packaged foods in India," said Anshu Mallick, MD & CEO of AWL Agri Business. Analysts are positive, with 67% maintaining a 'buy' or 'hold' stance, as per Bloomberg data.

Mutual funds raised their stake in Max Financial Services by 5 percentage points to 39.88%. The stock was up by around 3% in Q4. The firm, which holds a dominant position in the life insurance space, continues to enjoy analyst backing—100% of Bloomberg-tracked analysts maintain a 'buy' or 'hold' rating. YES Securities expects Q4

margins to expand to 23-24% on the back of operating leverage. However, the stock trades at a lofty 176.6x trailing P/E—twice its five-year average.

Digital services firm Happiest Minds Technologies saw MF holdings more than double to 8.37%, even as its share price slid 19%. HDFC Securities expects 25% dollar revenue growth in FY25, led by a revival in digital transformation demand. The stock trades at 36x FY26 earnings—below its long-term average of 45x. Its Q4 result will be announced on 12 May. South Indian Bank also saw strong interest, with mutual fund ownership jumping to 8.3% from 3.8%, despite a 7.8% drop in stock price.

# RIL aborts Operation Sindoor trademark bid

After backlash, Reliance says filing by junior staffer was not authorized

Reliance Industries Ltd (RIL) applied for but later withdrew its application for a trademark for "Operation Sindoor", the code-name for India's strike against terrorist bases in Pakistan and Pakistan-occupied Kashmir.

Jio Studios, a unit of Reliance Industries, said in a statement on Thursday afternoon that the application had been filed inadvertently by a junior person without authorization. Reliance Industries has no intention of trademarking Operation Sindoor, a phrase which is now part of the national consciousness as an evocative symbol of Indian bravery.

Reliance had applied for the word-type trademark under Class 41 on 7 May, the day of the military operation, information from the commerce ministry's trademark search portal showed. The firm's media and entertainment division offers news, entertainment, sports, movies and live entertainment across content formats.

Reliance Industries and all its stakeholders are "incredibly proud" of Operation Sindoor, which came about in response to a Pakistan-sponsored terrorist attack in Pahalgaon, the company said on Thursday. "Operation Sindoor is the proud achievement of our brave Armed Forces in India's uncompromising fight against the evil of terrorism," it said.

"Reliance stands fully in support of our government and armed forces in this fight against terrorism. Our commitment to the motto of 'INDIA FIRST' remains unwavering." A Class 41 trademark would provide the holder with the rights to exclusively use the word-type trademark. Reliance proposed to use it for entertainment purposes, including production, presentation and distribution of audio, video, or still and moving images and data containing the

trademark, according to the goods and services description in the application.

The trademark holder will be allowed to use it in publishing services like electronic publishing services, organisation, production and presentation of shows, competitions, games, concerts, exhibitions and events. The status of the application was

The trademark application triggered public criticism on social media. "We hereby withdraw our application no. 6994264 in class 41 filed for the mark Operation Sindoor," RIL told the registrar of trademarks. "You are requested to take the withdrawal letter on record and pass the order treating the application as withdrawn," it added.

"Formalities Chk Pass" as of 8 May morning, indicating no action has been taken by the trademark registry as yet, according to legal practitioners. The status means the applicant submitted information and documents and cleared the formalities check.

There are three other applicants for the trademark in the same class, according to information on trademark search portal.

In securing a trademark, the registry examines applications for any existing use of the trademark. The registry may raise queries regarding the mark's usage and whether there are any similar prior marks. If the queries are resolved, the registry will accept the mark.

# Merchant bankers of IPOs under Sebi lens

The market regulator's rare order barring First Overseas Capital Ltd (FOCL) from taking on any new initial public offering (IPO) assignments after uncovering alleged fund diversion from an IPO may signal increased scrutiny of merchant bankers, experts said.

The interim order, issued on 6 May by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi), uncovered a diversion of ₹19 crore from the proceeds of Synoptics Technologies' July 2023 IPO. It details how FOCL allegedly siphoned funds through fake counterparties, misclassified as expenses, and partially used to buy the company's own shares on listing day, creating an illusion of market demand.

Sebi's order sent a clear message about accountability, investor protection and thorough disclosure practices, said Tarun Singh, founder and MD at Highbrow Securities. "This is especially pertinent for SME IPOs, where information gaps can be more pronounced and retail investors may be more vulnerable to inadequate disclosures."

Sebi's action served as a reminder that merchant bankers cannot view SME listings as an area where standards can be relaxed, even if deal sizes are smaller, he said. It may lead to more thorough vetting processes and potentially longer timelines for some offerings, adding the alternative—a loss of investor confidence—would be far more damaging. "SME segment's progress has been built on gradually earned credibility; maintaining this trust is essential for its continued growth."

मध्यल्या काळात वृक्ष पडून होणारी जीवितहानी तसेच वित्तहानी टाळता यावी, यासाठी जर्मनीतील आधुनिक एमआरआय आधारीत यंत्राद्वारे वृक्षांची तपासणी (ट्री ऑडिट) करण्याचा निर्णय टाणे महापालिका प्रशासनाने घेतला होता. यासंबंधीचा प्रस्तावही तयार करण्यात आला होता. परंतु निधी अभावी हा प्रस्ताव

कागदावर राहिला असल्याची माहिती आता समोर आली आहे. त्यामुळे शहरातील वृक्ष तपासणी मोहीम देखील रूखडली आहे. या संदर्भात वृक्ष प्राधिकरण समितीचे सदस्य विक्रान्त तावडे आणि नम्रता भोसले यांनी गुरुवारी महापालिका आयुक्त सौरभ राव यांना निवेदन दिले आहे. महापालिका हद्दीत दरवर्षी वृक्ष उन्मळून पडल्याची घटना घडत आहेत. परंतु यंदा वृक्ष उन्मळून पडण्याच्या घटना टाळण्यासाठी महापालिकेने वृक्षांच्या फांद्या तोडण्याची मोहीम आधीच हाती



### जर्मनीतील यंत्र केवळ कागदावरच

जर्मनीतील आधुनिक एमआरआय आधारीत यंत्राद्वारे वृक्षांचे वय, आरोग्य, पोळणपणा, कीड लागलेली अवस्था, वाळवणीचा प्रादुर्भाव आणि धोका ओळखता येतो. यामुळे वृक्षांच्या सदृढतेचा अंदाज येतो आणि वृक्ष दुर्घटनाग्रस्त होण्यापूर्वी सशक्त करण्याबाबत किंवा काढण्याबाबत निर्णय घेण्यात येतो. यामुळे जीवित व वित्तहानी टाळता येते.

एकदा ऐरणीवर आला आहे. वृक्ष पडून जीवितहानी होऊ नये, यासाठी वृक्षांची तपासणी करण्याची मागणी सातत्याने होत असतानाही त्याकडे पालिकेचे दुर्लक्ष होत असल्याची बाब उघडकीस आली आहे. वृक्ष प्राधिकरण समितीचे माजी सदस्य विक्रान्त तावडे यांनी अशा प्रकारची मागणी पाच वर्षांपूर्वी केली होती आणि गेल्यावर्षी आयुक्तांची भेट घेऊन जर्मनीतील आधुनिक एमआरआय आधारीत यंत्राद्वारे वृक्षांची तपासणी (ट्री ऑडिट) करण्याबाबत माहिती दिली होती. मात्र, निधी उपलब्ध

वृक्षांची पाहणी करण्याची मागणी करूनही ती का केली जात नाही, असा प्रश्न उपस्थित करत धोकादायक वृक्षांच्या तक्रारी करूनही त्याकडे लक्ष दिले नाही आहे.

नसल्यामुळे हा प्रस्ताव कागदावरच राहिल्याची बाब समोर आली आहे.
